The Parks of Port Edwards

Port Edwards is fortunate to have six significant park facilities and a cemetery. The park system offers comprehensive recreational opportunities to the members of the community thanks to the generosity of many groups and organizations. The Village Board and staff take great pride in the parks system and work diligently to insure their sustainability for the public to enjoy for generations to come.

Ripple Creek Park:

Located at 670 VerBunker Ave, Ripple Creek Park offers about 30 acres of recreational diversity in a somewhat rural setting. Assets include:

- 1.7 acre pond with several benches to enjoy the vista
- 1800 sf outdoor shelter with charcoal grills, picnic tables, and electricity
- 16,000 sf playground with activity areas, swings, and numerous seating benches for relaxation and supervising children
- Tennis Court (reconstructed in 2012)
- Basketball Court (constructed in 2012)
- Three softball diamonds, with bleachers
- 18 acre wooded area with wood-chip hiking trails, wetlands, a creek, and benches to rest and enjoy nature
- 4,400 sf smaller playground with activity area
- Sledding hill
- Disc Golf Course
- Rest-room facilities with water/plumbing

Edwards-Alexander Park:

Located at 210 2nd Street, Edwards Alexander Park offers 2.3 acres of recreation in a peaceful residential setting. Assets include:

- 2,300 sf Edwards/Alexander indoor park shelter with kitchen. Reservable, fee required.
- 1,150 sf Edwards/Alexander outdoor shelter
- Playground with activity area, swings, etc.
- Splash Pad
- Sand volleyball
- Basketball
- Historic gazebo

Aubey Park:

Located at 1550 4th Street, Aubey Park is quiet neighborhood park 1.5 acres in size. Assets include:

- Open area large enough to play catch, or hit a ball around
- Playground with play equipment shaded with trees
- Basketball practice area
- Gazebo style picnic shelter with electricity

Jefferson Ave Park:

Located at 70 Jefferson Ave, the Jefferson Ave Park is a quiet neighborhood park .5 acre in size. Assets include:

- Playground area with play equipment, merry-go-round and swings
- Seating/observation bench
- Open grassy area
