

## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-02

### ADOPTING THE WOOD COUNTY ALL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN; September 2020

**INTENT & SYNOPSIS:** Approval of the Wood County All hazards Mitigation Plan to better prepare the Village for Hazard and Emergency mitigation and response.

**FISCAL NOTE:** The Village will remain eligible for certain State and federal grant programs as determined by the Department of Homeland Security with inclusion into this All Hazards Plan. No fiscal impact for the Village.

**WHEREAS,** The Village of Port Edwards recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property;  
and

**WHEREAS,** undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to people and property and save tax payer dollars; and


**WHEREAS,** an adopted all hazards plan is required as a condition of future grant funding for mitigation projects;  
and

**WHEREAS,** the Village of Port Edwards participated jointly in the planning process with Wood County and other local units of government within Wood County to prepare an All Hazards Mitigation Plan; and



Minor changes required on advice from the Wisconsin Emergency management and Federal Emergency Management will not require re-adopting this resolution.
