- **9.** New Business. Discussed the Fire district proposal as drafted by the City of Rome Fire Chief and Administrator. As of this initial informational meeting, there is no value for Port Edwards to become part of this organization, but we will monitor as it proceeds.
 - Initiated by Rome Fire department (Chief George Taub, Administrator Jami Gebert)
 - Gathers the existing Fire departments under one command/coordination umbrella
 - Individual departments pay a % fee quarterly (based on equalized value) to the District to sustain its
 operation
 - Supposedly synchronizes operations, training, standards, saves funds/time on duplicative efforts
 - Pools revenue to purchase equipment, Operations and training for all departments (maximizes revenue)
 - District President from Abbotsford/Colby/Dorchester Speaker (4 years in operation)
- The Initial information and briefing on this topic were lacking a Focus and Reason to create a District.
- The Speaker cited a coordination and lack of training issue that forced their creation- we do not have that issue in our region.

• Not having a clear reason or benefit to create a district distracts from the value of the topic

As for now The Village would not benefit from inclusion in a Fire District.

- We are well managed and operate effectively- a truly professional force
- Our funding is a combination of Contract fees and Village taxpayer funds
- Our Mutual Aid agreements with neighboring departments are well executed and we have no issues in execution
- Our manning is on the rise, especially with our pay raises this year, no manning issues present.
- Our fire department generates \$70K annually and we subsidize the remainder of their budget. They are the only Village element that generates income.
- Our Ambulance coverage has been outstanding and cost effective. In 2020 we had approx. 200 ambulance calls costing us \$18K, avg less than \$100 per call. Not to make this a financial discussion since lives are on the line, we could not run our own ambulance service for that cost.

Summary of monthly Activity

On 3/16 & 3/17 The Wood County Sheriff's Department hosted an annual pursuit driving training (EVOC), which we were invited to attend at no cost. All our full-time officers were able to meet our annual training requirements for pursuit driving, because of the generosity of the Sheriff and his staff.

On 3/26/21, Officer Abbott had Officer Paltz and K9 Kubo from the Wisconsin Rapids Police Department did a search at the PEMS/PEHS. No contraband was located.

We are continuing to spend extra time in the area of Port Road/Seneca Road watching for overweight violations. Enforcement action is being taken when violations are observed. 3 citations were issued this month for Weight Violations.

On 3/23/21, I contacted Google Maps and Waze Maps and requested the roadways be downgraded in their systems. The hope is that this route will not be the preferred route given to out of town drivers. I did hear back from Waze, who told me that they downgraded both Port Rd and Seneca Roads from "Collector" to "Local" streets. As of 4/2/21, I have not noticed a change in traffic flow.


