

1. Call to order: Meeting called to order by Ray Bossert at 6:15 p.m.

2. Roll Call: All Present.

- **3.** The Annual Joint Review Board meeting regarding the 2022 TID Annual report for the Tax Incremental District (TID) Number #2, in the Village of Port Edwards, Wisconsin, was held on 21 June 2022 at the Pittsville Community Hall, located at 5291 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Pittsville, Wisconsin.
- **4.** The TIF annual report was provided to the members as well as the PE-300 form filed with the Wisconsin Department of Revenue on February 4, 2023. Both were reviewed and approved.
- 5. An Update on the TIF Capital projects was given to the Board specifically the 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Road project at Ver bunker and Market Ave projects. Informed the board that while there will be no amendments to the Plan, internal adjustments have been planned for the renaming of some projects- the scope and cost will remain the same. For example, the bridge and business park projects may not be funded and the Market Ave Alley project will become the 2<sup>nd</sup> street market Ave project for the same cost, including the 2<sup>nd</sup> street project at Ver Bunker for 2024. These directly impact the TIF and were determined necessary for the ongoing and future development of the TIF district. These were acknowledged by the Joint Review board with no issues.
- **6.** The Members asked to clarify the Village plan to end or continue the TID. The administrator stated the Board will decide by June of next year, since the potential closure period will be September 2024.
- 7. Next meeting date: Tentative June 2024, at Pittsville.


