- 3. Review Certified Survey Map submitted by Great Northern Timber Company, LLC, located in the N ½ of NW ¼ of Section 31, Township 22 North, Range 6 East: The committees reviewed the survey map. Request for Village to address short-term property rentals: Scott Harrington said that the Village doesn't have an ordinance regulating short-term rentals and that the State budget was passed and signed into law to prohibit local municipalities to regulate short-term rentals, when owners are renting for 7 days or more. Municipalities may prohibit short term rentals 6 days or less and any person who operates a short-term rental for more than 10 nights per year must obtain a license from the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection and a license from a local municipality in required. Scott Harrington and Lorelei Fuehrer are going to gather information from other municipalities to create an ordinance for short-term rentals to bring back to the committee for review in the future.
- 5. *Discussion regarding plat and zoning of DMI property 100 Wisconsin River Drive:* Scott Harrington explained and reviewed the plat map and zoning requirements of the DMI property to the committee and Plan Commission.
- 6. *Correspondence received:* Students from the high school had contacted committee members to inquire about moving the John Edwards statue from the DMI location to the high school.
