Minutes of the Village of Port Edwards Police and Fire Commission

Monday, December 3rd, 2018 6:30 p.m. Port Edwards Municipal Building

Present: Commissioners Kasten, Thomasgard, Tyler, Blum, and Stewart. Also present were Fire Chief Arendt and Interim Police Chief Radtke.

Meeting called to order by President Stewart at 6:33 p.m.

Motion by Thomasgard, second by Blum to approve the minutes of the November 15th meeting. All in favor.

Chief Arendt reported on Fire Dept. activities for November. See attached detailed report. FD is focusing on training and certification of firefighters. Noted that coop training was held with Rome on 11/3 and with WR on 11/20. The WR training focused on back, neck and head injuries and is provided as a part of the Village contract with WR for EMS service. This also saves money regards re-certification. Chief Arendt also reported that the new engine being built for the Village by Darley in Chippewa Falls is progressing nicely and delivery should occur shortly after the first of the year.

Interim Chief Radtke submitted his November activity report (attached). He has been working on scheduling officers and has a schedule constructed for the next 4 months. He has been busy with administrative duties since being appointed Interim Chief in mid-November and feels that the 2 full time and 3 part time officers can cover the needs of the Village for the next few months.

President Stewart inquired about the status of the applications for the open part-time officer position. Interim Chief Radtke noted only a few applicants had responded so he canceled the proposed testing that had been scheduled for late November and the process is currently on hold pending additional interest. Applications will still be accepted and the Village Board agreed to raise the pay for part-time officers in 2019.

Discussion followed regarding Section 3.08 of Chapter 3 of the PEPFC Manual related to hiring of part-time police officers. In light of the limited response to the current part-time opening and the concerns expressed by some experienced potential applicants, the commission voted to add an amendment (attached) to Chapter 3, Sec3.08 of the PEPFC Manual removing the testing requirements for full time experienced or retired officers wishing to work part-time for the Port Edwards Police Department. Motion by Blum, second by Kasten. All in favor.

The Commission voted to go into closed session pursuant to WI Statute Sec.19.85(1)(c) at 7:25 p.m. Motion by Tyler, second by Kasten. All in favor.

The Commission voted to come out of closed session at 7:45 p.m. Motion by Tyler, second by Kasten. All in favor. No action was taken as a result of the closed session.

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the PEPFC will be on Monday, January 7th at 6:30 at the Port Edwards Municipal Building. Motion to adjourn by Blum, second by Tyler. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:49 p.m.
