Subjects Discussed, Action Taken, and Board Action Required:

- 1. *Call to order:* Meeting called to order by S. Mitchell.
- 2. Roll Call: All present.
- 3. *Approve the previous months minutes:* <u>MOTION</u> (Zurfluh/Saylor) to approve previous months minutes. Motion carried. All aye.
- 4. Public comments on agenda items: Nothing noted.
- 5. *Committee Chairman's comments:* Nothing noted.
- 6. *Review proposal and possible action on replacing catch basins on Market Avenue:* Discussed the pros and cons of concrete vs. plastic for the 4th catch basins on Market Avenue Lifetime of plastic would be 15-20 years, but costs more, approximately \$1,800.00. Concrete lifetime about 10 years and cost approximately ? . Look at bids at the next meeting. This would come out of the TIF.
- 7. *3rd Street project update:* Bid came in much higher, \$90,000.00 \$132,000.00 from Wood County Highway Department. Lorelei, Ben and Mark to meet with the county to discuss.
- Splash Pad update: Splash pad to be put on a timer from 10:00 am 8:00 pm to conserve water. Last payment to MSA was 7/15 for the fixtures. Projected ribbon cutting date August 10/11 to coincide with Fun Fest. Discussion about a "thank you" sign to the Legacy Foundation.
- 9. 6th Street Development update: Property lines have been marked, nothing else new. Attorney Nick Abts to be involved.
- 10. *Medical Arts building remodel project update:* There have been five roof leaks on the Medical Arts building. Option 1: seal roof, cost of \$400.00 \$500.00. Option 2: redo entire roof, cost of \$15,045 guarantee of 10 years.

- 11. *Jetting at north Port Road:* R&R jetted north end of Port Road three weeks ago, found a root structure in pipe, once the obstruction was removes water was flowing and after two days there was no longer standing water. Ben will talk with R&R to have them do the other half of Port Road from Ver Bunker Avenue towards Seneca Road.
- 12. *MSA engineering:* Bid for Market Avenue to go to the FHR committee.
- 13. Sampson Road: MOTION (Zurfluh/Mancl) to move this item to a future agenda. Motion passed. All aye.
- 14. *Payment for treatment of boulevard ash tree on Wisconsin River Drive:* John Bingham requested the Village to pay for half of the treatment of the ash tree on his property but in the Village boulevard. Grant opportunities will be explored.
- 15. *Weight limit signs on Port & Seneca Roads:* Signs are up for weight restrictions on Port Road. Signs are up on 54 from both directions as well.
- 16. 4-way stop signs at Port Road & Ver Bunker Avenue: Delayed until we have a Village Administrator.
- 17. *Electrical outlet on back of wall at cemetery for Memorial Day ceremony:* Village Administrator and Public Works Foreman will discuss options.
- 18. Appointment of SIRC chair and President to represent Village in discussion about weed equipment from Pavloski Development: Village President and SIRC Chair to meet with Pavloski to discuss further.
- 19. Department of Public Works report: Nothing noted.
