- Call to order: Meeting called to order by Mancl Chairman at 4:00 p.m.
- *Roll Call:* All present from above.
- Approve the previous month's minutes & agenda: MOTION (Mancl/Mitchell) to approve minutes from 24 February 2022 & agenda. Motion carried.
- Public comments on agenda items: None.

- Parks & Recreation Updates.
 - a. Discussion on Village Rummage sale for 20-21 May 2022.
 - i. Permits. Village policy states there is a \$5 permit for a yard sale, the fee will be waived. Recommendation if you are selling food in bulk, that the \$5 fee is required. The fire department will be hosting the Bike Rodeo on Saturday & Scentrail group wants to host a raffle to advertise the dog parks.
 - ii. Porta Johns. DMI is covering the cost of them, locations will be at the north end, center, & Brentwood area.
 - **iii. Advertising/Mapping.** Building a digital map on Google Maps to show locations of the sales, porta johns, food vendors, & Goodwill truck.

- **iv. Goodwill truck.** Will be located at the Port Edwards Fire Station Saturday & Sunday to donate items. They will have a list of items they do not accept. Bulk pickup will be the weekend after the sale.

Installation will be over the summer. Ripple Creek walkway going into the pond from the skating shed will be replaced. Depending on funding, the riprap on Ver Bunker will be replaced. Dog park will have perimeter fencing installed late April/early May.
