Regular Monthly Meeting

- *Call to order:* Meeting called to order by Chairman Radtke at 4:00 p.m.
- *Roll Call:* All present from above.
- *Approve the previous month's agenda*: <u>MOTION</u> (Radtke/McGregor) to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- Approve the previous month's minutes: <u>MOTION</u> (Saylor/McGregor) to approve the minutes from 17 March 2022. **Motion carried.**
- Public comments on agenda items: None.
- Committee Chairman's comments: None.
- Public Works Updates
 - a. Road Work.
 - i. 4th Street milling & paving were scheduled to start this week but Wood County's paver had a mechanical failure, pushing work until 17 July. 4th St. had a new curb & gutter installed last week. Water main break on 4th & Seneca was fixed within 24 hours & also replaced north end fire hydrant. Port Rd. will have chip sealing in June. 3rd St. rehab, the product has been ordered, awaiting arrival; should be done by 1 August. Crack filling on 3rd will be done in June.

- In late July, will be painting road lines. Next week Tuesday & Wednesday the hydrants will be flushed.
- **ii.** Wells & sanitation plant. Finished up well 4, pulled out to clean to increase efficiency. The water tower at Ripple Creek is not leaking, it is just condensation, will be pressure washed in June/July.
- *Discussion on wastewater system repairs*. Used most of the funds out of the reserve account to fix issues. One of the UV lights in the river went out, \$3,500. Replaced a bearing on one of the pumps, \$2k. PLC had a failure, \$3k.

MOTION (Radtke/McGregor) to replenish the day-to-day operational sanitation fund for the unexpected repairs out of the operational accounts with the wastewater equipment fund at \$10,000. This will reduce the equipment fund to \$96,000. **Motion carried.**

- *Old Business*. Ongoing Hwy 54/73 project by DOT. They will be adding a crosswalk at the far end of Port Rd. Replacement of Hwy 73, easements get bought out next week. Utilities will be done next year. Curb & movements in Spring of 2024.
- New Business.
 - a. Collaboration between Wisconsin Rapids, Grand Rapids, & Port Edwards on the chipseal of Sampson Street (near the airport). Our portion of cost is \$5k. This will be conducted in August or September of this year. These funds will come from our NEPCO planning fund account.

MOTION (Radtke/Saylor)to approve \$5k of funding from the Planning Fund to cover costs for Sampson Street. **Motion carried.**

b. Annual wastewater report. Our rating & levels are at an acceptable level. No concerns.

MOTION resolution no. #2022-06 to move to the full board (Radtke/McGregor) **motion carried.**
